What is the Advanced Track?

This guide shows what is taught in the higher stages of the program. The Advanced Track helps students move from an upper-intermediate level to a highly fluent, precise, and professional speaker who can command complex conversations with total ease. This matches the international CEFR C1 and C2 standards.

Simple Monthly Billing: Even though the program is split into 3-month steps to help students learn smoothly, classes are billed month by month. There are no contracts or long-term commitments.

WHAT STUDENTS WILL LEARN

Level 1: Advanced English Part 1 **CEFR C1**

Duration: 3 Months Billed Monthly • **Goal:** Express Ideas Fluently and Spontaneously

- **Nuanced Expression:** Learn to use precise vocabulary, idioms, and phrasal verbs to express exact feelings and thoughts without searching for words.
 - **Professional & Social Skills:** Practice leading business meetings, giving persuasive presentations, and navigating complex social settings with native speakers.
 - **Complex Sentence Structures:** Master advanced grammar, including inversion, advanced conditionals, and subtle emphasis to make your speech sound more natural.
 - **Real-Life Analysis:** Discuss and debate complex topics like global news, culture, and business trends comfortably.
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Level 2: Advanced English Part 2 **CEFR C1**

Duration: 3 Months Billed Monthly • Goal: Command Professional and Academic Communication

- **Advanced Writing & Reports:** Learn to write clear, well-structured emails, reports, and essays on complex subjects, using an appropriate professional tone.
 - **Idiomatic Fluency:** Master common English metaphors, cultural references, and colloquialisms used in daily professional and casual life.
 - **Critical Listening:** Build skills to fully understand fast-paced conversations, podcasts, and lectures, even when the topic is unfamiliar.
 - **Debate & Negotiation:** Practice defending an opinion, handling counter-arguments, and negotiating effectively in professional situations.
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Level 3: Advanced English Part 3 **CEFR C1**

Duration: 3 Months Billed Monthly • Goal: Achieve Total Conversational Independence

- **Implicit Meaning:** Learn to read between the lines and understand sarcasm, subtle humor, and unstated implications in both conversation and media.

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Level 4: Proficiency English Part 1 **CEFR C2**

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Level 5: Proficiency English Part 2 **CEFR C2**

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Level 6: Proficiency English Part 3 **CEFR C2**

Duration: 3 Months Billed Monthly • Goal: Total Mastery and Complete Bilingual Fluency

- **Complete Conceptual Freedom:** Discuss highly abstract, technical, or philosophical topics with absolute ease, precision, and zero mental effort.
 - **Executive Presentation:** Practice delivering high-stakes speeches, answering hostile questions smoothly, and commanding any room with professional authority.
 - **Media & Literature Critique:** Analyze and critique dense literary works, legal materials, and complex media pieces with total linguistic comfort.
 - **The Graduation Sprint:** Participate in intensive, realistic simulation challenges designed to prove your absolute command of the English language at a flawless level.
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UNDERSTANDING LANGUAGE LEVELS (CEFR)

The CEFR framework is an international standard used worldwide to describe how well a person speaks a foreign language, ranging from A1 (Beginner) to C2 (Native Level).

Level	Title	What a student can do:
A1	Beginner	Understand and use simple everyday words and basic phrases to express simple needs.
A2	Elementary	Understand simple sentences about daily life, family, shopping, work, and local geography.
B1	Intermediate	Deal with travel situations and talk about familiar topics like work, school, hobbies, and personal dreams.
B2	Upper Intermediate	Understand the main points of complex reading texts and speak fluidly with native speakers without stress.
C1	Advanced	Understand long, difficult texts. Speak fluently, naturally, and spontaneously for social, professional, or school purposes.
C2	Proficient	Understand almost everything heard or read with ease. Speak perfectly and express subtle shades of meaning clearly.
